**Flag Football** O CPR will continue to participate in the North Osage County Flag Football League. The league is operated by the Carbondale Rec Association. Forms are available now and will be sent through the schools once school starts. Games are played mid-September through the end of October. Games are played on Sunday, in either Carbondale or Burlingame. Grade divisions for the league are, 6 & Under, 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, and 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Grade.

**Tackle Football** O CPR will continue to participate in the Emporia Recreation Commissioner Tackle Football League. The league is operated by the Emporia Rec Commission. Emporia Rec supplies all equipment for the players. The team has 25 kids on it. Games begin on September 8, and continue on Saturdays through the end of October. All games are played in Emporia.

A Facility Update was given by the recreation director.

#### Jones Park Complex

Trees will be added on the North side of the asphalt walkway as you enter to the complex from the West. The trees will be planted by Shroud's of New Strawn, and they will maintain the trees for a minimum of two years.

A shelter will be constructed South of the concession building, in the general area of when the asphalt stops. The purpose of the shelter is to provide shade for fans as they watch games.

Landscape options located around the flag and the Hultgren Memorial were not approved. The landscape options were to be provided by the Osage City Scouts as an eagle scout project.

The recreation director discussed the park board member rotation, as well as, a new appointment to the park board. Will Kerns will be the School Board representative, taking the place of Pat Bean. The School Board choose who their representative to the park board will be.
